RESOLUTION NO. 322

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP AGREEING TO
PARTICIPATE IN THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, there has been organized in Franklin County among several of the governmental entities located in the County a forum under the name Franklin County Council of Governments by which various governmental entities located within Franklin County may meet to discuss issues of mutual interest and to coordinate their various governmental activities,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township to participate in the forum to discuss matters of mutual interest,

WHEREAS, Section 3, paragraph B of the Organizational Charter of the forum affords membership to any governmental body located in Franklin County which elects to participate pursuant to a resolution of the respective governmental body indicating its intent to participate and identifying governmental body's voting delegate and alternate,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of this Township as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Washington Township desires to participate in the Franklin County Council of Governments subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The Council shall not have any authority to impose any fee on the Township of Washington or to impose any obligation on it to generate a fee without the express approval of the Board of Supervisors at a legally sufficient public meeting first approved.
 - b. No decision of the Council shall be binding upon the Township of Washington without the express approval of the Board of Supervisors at a legally sufficient public meeting first approved.
 - c. The Township of Washington reserves the right to withdrawal from participation in the Council at any time by adopting a resolution to withdrawal and forwarding the same to the Council.

2. The Board of Supervisors of Washington Township does hereby designate Michael A. Christopher, Township Manager, as its voting delegate, and Gerald L. Zeigler, Code Enforcement Officer, as its alternate voting delegate for the Franklin County Council of Governments.
