

**TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 340**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP
APPROVING TRANSFER OF RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE: R-17543 INTO
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP FROM QUINCY TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, Act 141 of 2000 (“the Act”), which amends the Commonwealth’s Liquor Code, authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Board to approve, in certain instances, the transfer of restaurant liquor licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county regardless of the quota limitations provided for in Section 461 of the Liquor Code, if sales of liquor and malt or brewed beverages are legal in the municipality receiving the license; and

WHEREAS, the receiving municipality issues a resolution approving the transfer of the license from outside the municipality to inside the municipality; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Liquor Code stipulate that, prior to adoption of a resolution by the receiving municipality, at least one hearing be held for the purpose of permitting interested parties to state their concerns regarding the transfer of a liquor licensee into the receiving municipality; and

WHEREAS, an application for transfer filed under the Act must contain a copy of the resolution adopted by the municipality approving the transfer of a liquor license into the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Chestnut Logs, Inc., has requested the approval of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania liquor license to its facilities within Washington Township, which will trade as Chestnut Logs, Inc., with the understanding that said transfer must be approved at a later date by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township has held a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed liquor license transfer and, after consideration of the issues, finds that the transfer of a liquor license into Washington Township by Chestnut Logs, Inc., will result in job creation, revenue enhancement and dining accommodations for the residents of Washington Township, all of which will substantially benefit the local economy and residents; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Washington Township approves, by adoption of this Resolution, the proposed transfer of liquor license R17543 into Washington Township by Chestnut Logs, Inc.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the license transfer is subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
