RESOLUTION NO. 366

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP  
AMENDING THE 1999 WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP  
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

**WHEREAS**, on February 17, 1999, the Washington Township Supervisors adopted an updated Comprehensive Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, recent amendments to the Pennsylvania Municipal Planning code requires the Township's Comprehensive Plan to be generally consistent with the Township's Zoning Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has received an application to rezone approximately 26.5 acres of land currently zoned A to R-1; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to keep the Comprehensive Plan consistent with the Zoning Ordinance by amending the Comprehensive Plan to mirror the requested zoning changes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:


**Section 1.** Amends the Future Agricultural Land Use Plan, 12; the Future Residential Land Use Plan, M14; and the Comprehensive Land Use Plan to reflect the following residential zoning changes:

Property of Darlene E. Patterson located at 5345 and 5401 Tick Ridge Road – Change approximately 26.5 acres on the north side of Tick Ridge Road and one lot west of Koons Road from Agricultural (A) to Low Density Residential (R-1).
