RESOLUTION NO. 372

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP
AMENDING THE 1999 WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, on February 17, 1999, the Washington Township Supervisors adopted an updated Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, recent amendments to the Pennsylvania Municipal Planning code require the Township's Comprehensive Plan to be generally consistent with the Township's Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Township has received an application to rezone approximately 36 acres of land currently zoned A to R-1; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to keep the Comprehensive Plan consistent with the Zoning Ordinance by amending the Comprehensive Plan to mirror the requested zoning changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:


Section 1. Amends the Future Agricultural Land Use Plan, 12; the Future Residential Land Use Plan, M14; and the Comprehensive Land Use Plan to reflect the following residential zoning changes:

Property of Mary A. Martin located approximately 1700 feet north of Stottlemeyer Road – Change approximately 36 acres North of the Martins Ridge Development, East of the Knepper Farm, South of the Middour Farm, and West of the Eigenbrode Farm from Agricultural (A) to Low Density Residential (R-1).
