RESOLUTION NO. 393

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT A PENNSYLVANIA CHESAPEAKE BAY TRIBUTARY STRATEGY SPECIAL STUDY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT, ACT 537, AND TOWNSHIP WASTEWATER TO EVALUATE FUTURE SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the wastewater treatment facilities of the Washington Township Municipal Authority (WTMA) are located within the geographical areas of various tributaries to the Chesapeake Bay; and

WHEREAS, due to certain laws and regulations requiring increased nutrient reduction to comply with total nitrogen and phosphorous limits at design flows, a Pennsylvania Chesapeake Bay Tributary Strategy Special Study must be conducted as a supplement to the Washington Township's Act 537 Plan.

WHEREAS, proposed growth within Washington Township exceeds previously planned growth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:

The WTMA is hereby directed and authorized to undertake the Pennsylvania Chesapeake Bay Tributary Strategy Special Study as a supplement to the Township's Act 537 Plan and to update the Township's Act 537 Plan to provide for the future growth in the Township, based on the proposal, or any amendment thereof presented by CET Engineering Services.
