RESOLUTION NO. 396

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP  
AMENDING THE 1999 WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP  
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

**WHEREAS**, on February 17, 1999, the Washington Township Supervisors adopted an updated Comprehensive Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, recent amendments to the Pennsylvania Municipal Planning code require the Township's Comprehensive Plan to be generally consistent with the Township's Zoning Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has received an application to rezone approximately 12.64 acres of land currently zoned R-2 to C; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to keep the Comprehensive Plan consistent with the Zoning Ordinance by amending the Comprehensive Plan to mirror the requested zoning changes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:


**Section 1.** Amends the Future Commercial & Industrial Land Use Plan, M13; the Future Residential Land Use Plan, M14; and the Comprehensive Land Use Plan, M16, to reflect the following residential and commercial zoning changes:


The C. David and Barbara J. Layman property located at 12707 Old Forge Road – change 12.64 acres from Medium Density Residential (R-2) to Commercial (C).
