RESOLUTION NO. 486

RESOLUTION OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter "the municipality").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, on behalf of Washington Township, the Washington Township Municipal Authority has prepared an Act 537 Plan Special Study on nutrient removal alternatives which serves as a supplement to the Official Sewage Facilities Plan and provides for upgraded sewage facilities for the Township, and


WHEREAS, the chosen alternative recommends additions and alterations to the existing wastewater treatment plan through equipment and process programming changes to the existing sequencing batch reactor, construction of chemical storage/feed facilities for total phosphorous reduction, and improvements to the existing digester as listed in the Act 537 Plan Special Study. The key implementation activities/dates are listed in the Act 537 Plan Special Study.

WHEREAS, Washington Township finds that the Act 537 Plan Special Study, described above, addresses the Pennsylvania Chesapeake Bay Tributary Strategy's effluent requirements and conforms to applicable municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Washington Township Board of Supervisors this 6th day of July, 2009, hereby adopts and submits to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a supplement to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Act 537 Plan Special Study.


