RESOLUTION NO. 502

BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ELIMINATING MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE POLICE PENSION FUND. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 5.03 OF ORDINANCE NO. 177 FOR YEARS 2009 AND 2010.

WHEREAS, Section 5.03 of Ordinance No. 177, known as the Police Pension Fund Ordinance, provides for the elimination of member contributions to the Police Pension Fund on an annual basis, if an actuarial study shows that the condition of the Police Pension Fund is such that payments into the fund by members may be eliminated, and that if such payments are eliminated, contributions by the Township will not be required to keep the fund actuarially sound; and


WHEREAS, the last actual study the township received indicated that eliminating member contributions for the plan years 2009 and 2010 will not affect the actuarial soundness of the fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township that in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.03 of Ordinance No. 177 and the actuarial report received by the Township, member contributions to the Police Pension Fund for the fund years 2009 and 2010 are hereby eliminated.


