**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
UPDATING THE ESTABLISHED EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN  
FOR WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S.A. Section 7101 et seq. mandates that townships prepare, maintain and keep current an emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this Township; and

**WHEREAS**, in response to the mandate stated above, this Township has prepared an emergency operations plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster; and


**WHEREAS**, this Township has also prepared an emergency operations plan in order to reduce the potential effects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Township; and

**WHEREAS**, from time to time, this plan shall be updated to keep it current.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors hereby approves, adopts and places into immediate effect the enclosed Emergency Operations Plan for Washington Township. It is further resolved that the Township will review this Emergency Operations Plan to make certain that it conforms with the requirements of the Franklin County Emergency Operations Guideline every two years.
