

**TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

RESOLUTION NO. 699

**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP
APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A BOX CULVERT TO
REPLACE THE EXISTING BRIDGE AT WYNDHAM
AVENUE OVER RED RUN.**

WHEREAS, the hazardous condition of the existing bridge on Wyndham Avenue over Red Run in Blue Ridge Summit, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania has necessitated the closure of the bridge until it is replaced; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the bridge on Wyndham Avenue will require approval and permitting from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection; and

WHEREAS, the Township obtained an Emergency Permit on July 2, 2019, from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to replace the bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Permit issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection will expire in 60 days unless extended by the Department; and

WHEREAS, the normal bidding process for construction projects will take longer than the 60 days allotted for replacement of the bridge under the Emergency Permit; and

WHEREAS, the concrete bottomless box culvert specifically approved by the Department of Environmental Protection for the replacement of the bridge on this site would be fabricated as a precast concrete product by Monarch Products Company for installation at the Wyndham Avenue bridge location at a quoted price of \$35,800 plus tax; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 3102(h)(1) of the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors may, without advertising, bidding, or price quotations, purchase/contract for emergency or routine maintenance, repairs, or replacements for public works if they do not constitute new additions, extensions, or enlargements of existing facilities; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the concrete bottomless box culvert on Wyndham Avenue would only replace the existing structure and would not constitute a new additions, extensions, or enlargements of existing facilities.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the purchase of a concrete box culvert from Monarch Products Company for the quoted price of \$35,800 plus tax for the

replacement of the existing bridge at Wyndham Avenue is hereby approved by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township.
