An ordinance ordaining, laying out and opening certain roads in Rouzerville, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to wit; Broad Street and the first alley West of the intersection of Broad Street and old Route #16.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same;

ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center of old Route #16, in the Village of Rouzerville, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, at comer of lands of Clyde Cordell and Glenn Smith; thence North 61 degrees 53 minutes East 364.1 feet to a point; thence North 60 degrees 39 minutes West 191 feet to a point, thence North 60 degrees 55 minutes West 209.7 feet to a point; thence North 62 degrees 26 minutes West 349.9 feet to a point; thence North 84 degrees 08 minutes West 36.6 feet to a point; thence North 69 degrees 37 minutes West 348.7 feet to a point in the center line of the township road at corner of lands of Charles S. Gardner, Jr., said road having a width of 33 feet.

SECTION II: That a certain alley intersecting old Route #16 and Broad Street in Rouzerville, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center line of old Route #16, at comer of lands of Andrew Ziegler, and the Rouzerville Lutheran Church; thence North 27 degrees 13 minutes East 509.8 feet to a point in the center line of Broad Street as ordained, laid out and opened in Section I of this ordinance, and having a width of 20 feet.

SECTION III: There is adopted as a part of this ordinance, a plan and map of the foregoing road and alley, showing the width and location thereof, as prepared by John H. McClellan, R.S., November 1,5,8,9, 1954, and available for inspection at the office of the Secretary, Melvin T. Sease, Rouzerville, Pennsylvania.

SECTION IV. Said road and alley shall hereafter be and become a part of the public roud system of Washington Township.
