Washington Township Ordinance No. 10

An Ordinance ordaining, laying out, and opening a certain road at Blue Ridge Summit, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to-wit, Blue Ridge Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That a certain road to be known as Blue Ridge Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center line of Township Road No. 377, which point is 384 feet Westwardly from the center line of Monterey Avenue; thence south 2 degrees west 725 feet to a point; thence south 5 degrees 30 minutes west 164 feet to a point; thence south 0 degrees 48 minutes west 250 feet to a point; thence south 45 degrees 30 minutes west 542 feet to a point; thence south 46 degrees 18 minutes west 496 feet to a point; thence south 46 degrees 33 minutes west 1371 feet to a point on the Mason-Dixon Line at the junction of a public road of Washington County, Maryland, said road having a total length of 3548 feet and being 33 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

SECTION 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. Atherton, C.S., surveyed November 6, 1952 and December 1, 1956.

SECTION 3. Said road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township,

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 4th day of November, 1957.
