ORDINANCE NO. 13

An Ordinance Ordaining, Laying Out And Opening a Certain Road in Blue Ridge Summit, Washington Township, to wit: Summit Plaza

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That a certain road named Summit Plaza be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point on the Easterly edge of Pennsylvania Highway Legislative Route No. 28027, known as Monterey Avenue, which point lies between lands of Dr. Harry H. Youngs, Jr., and wife, and lands of Blue Ridge Summit Free Library; thence South 71 degrees 45 minutes East 260 feet to a point on the Westerly side of Washington Township Road No. 692, known as Summit Avenue, which point lies between lands of the First National Bank of Blue Ridge Summit and lands of the Blue Ridge Summit Free Library and opposite lands of the Episcopal Parish House, said road having a total length of 260 feet and being 50 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

SECTION 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, June 1, 1960.

SECTION 3. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 2nd day of January, 1961.
