Washington Township Ordinance No. 15

An Ordinance laying out and opening a certain road at Wayne Heights, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to-wit: Twin Hill Drive.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That a certain road to be known as Twin Hill Drive be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center line of Pennsylvania Legislative Highway Route No. 44, Traffic Route No. 16, which point is distant 629.4 feet North 72 degrees 45 minutes West from the intersection of the center line of Washington Township Road No. 372 with the center line of Pennsylvania Legislative Route No. 44; thence South 8 degrees 50 minutes West 240 feet to a point; thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 324.8 feet, a distance of 119.85 feet; thence South 29 degrees 45 minutes West 903.4 feet to a point at the boundary line of lands of L. R. Hoover, said road having a total length of 1263.25 feet and being 50 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

SECTION 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated September 18-20, 1961.

SECTION 3. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 2nd day of April, 1962.
