ORDINANCE NO. 16

An Ordinance to amend and supplement the Land Subdivision and Street Construction Regulations of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania as enacted by Washington Township Ordinance No. 7 adopted May 11, 1957 and effective June 1, 1957.

Pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Act of May 1, 1933 P.L. 103 as Amended and supplemented (53 P.S. 66251 to 66258, the following Amendment and Supplement to the Land Subdivision and Street Construction Regulations of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, are hereby adopted for Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, effective July 15, 1962.

- Section 1. Section 3, subsection (m) of Washington Township Ordinance No. 7 shall be and is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: In the application of the CP-2 black top, a minimum of one and eight tenths (1.8) gallons of oil shall be used for each square yard of surface. Only oils of the following designation shall be used: Asphalt Cl, NCl; Tar H3; Emulsion Fl, F2, F3.
- Section 2. Section 3 of Washington Township Ordinance No. 7 shall be supplemented by the addition of subparagraph (p) as follows:
- (p) Where lots in a subdivision are to be served by a public water supply or public sewer service and mains are to be laid in the road right-of-way, latterals to each lot in said subdivision shall be laid from the mains to the edge of the road right-of-way before the base and road surface are applied.
