## ORDINANCE NO. 17

An Ordinance laying out and opening a certain road at Zullinger, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to-wit: Shady Lane.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. That a certain road to be known as Shady Lane be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center line of Pennsylvania Legislative Highway Route No. 224, Traffic Route No. 16, in the village of Zullinger which point is at Pennsylvania Highway Station No. and is located between lands of Charles D. Freeman and Helen Freeman on the East, and lands of Robert R. Cutchall and Martha Cutchall on the West; thence North 18 degrees East 741 feet to a point located between lands of Crawford E. Howe on the West, and lands of C. E. Ritter Estate on the East, said road having a total length of 741 feet and being 35 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

Section 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated May 21, 1962.

Section 3. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 2nd day of July, 1962.
