

ORDINANCE NO. 19

An Ordinance laying out and opening certain roads at Zullinger, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to-wit: New Street and Grace Street.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. That a certain road to be known as New Street be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center line of Pennsylvania Highway Route 16 in the Village of Zullinger, which point is 506.2 feet Westwardly from a nail marking the center line of Shady Lane and is located between lands of Emory Newcomer on the East and lands of Leroy Plum on the West; thence north 18 degrees east 439.5 feet to a point at lands of Edwin D. Zody and Anna M. Zody, his wife, said road having a total length of 439.5 feet and being 35 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

Section 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated June 28, 1962.

Section 3. That a certain road to be known as Grace Street be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center line of Pennsylvania Highway Route 16 in the Village of Zullinger, which point is 361.9 feet Westwardly from a nail marking the center line of New Street and is located between

lands of N. B. Gordon on the East and lands of A. Frank Powell on the West; thence north 18 degrees east 443.6 feet at lands of Edwin D. Zody and Anna M. Zody, his wife, said roadway having a total length of 443.6 feet and being 33 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

Section 4. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated June 28, 1962.

Section 5. The aforesaid two roads shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 1st day of October, 1962.
