

ORDINANCE NO. 25

An Ordinance re-enacting Ordinance No. 23, imposing an excise tax on the privilege of transferring real estate situate in part or in whole within the Township of Washington by deed; prescribing the due date; providing for liability, reporting, payment and collection of the tax; making exemptions; imposing duties of the recorder of deeds of Franklin County as special tax collector for the Township of Washington for such taxes; providing compensation for the collection thereof; providing for a lien; prescribing penalties and interest for non-payment and prescribing penalties for violations of the provisions thereof.

Pursuant to and under the authority granted by the Local Tax Enabling Act of 1965 (53 P.S. 6901-6924) of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as The "Township of Washington Realty Transfer Tax Ordinance of 1967".

Section 2. Imposition of the Tax. A tax for general revenue purposes at the rate of one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}\%$ ) percent of the value of the real estate, lands, tenements, or hereditaments, or any interest therein which is conveyed or transferred by deed during the period beginning July 1, 1967, and ending December 31, 1967.

Section 3. The provisions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 of Washington Township Ordinance No. 23 are incorporated herein by reference and re-enacted hereby.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1967.
