ORDINANCE NO. 30

An Ordinance ordaining, laying out and opening a certain road in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvaina, to wit: Cross Street.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. That a certain road named Cross Street be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, extended and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a iron pin marking the center line of West Avenue with the center line of Cross Street, said iron pin marking Station 3+77.5 of the center line of West Avenue and Station 0+00 of the center line of Cross Street; thence north 4 degrees 54 minutes west to Station 4+27.6 of the center line of Cross Street and Station 29+52.08 of Legislative Route 28023, said road having a total length of 427.6 feet and being 40 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

Section 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, C.S., April 1 and 2, 1968.

Section 3. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 1st day of July, 1968.
