

ORDINANCE NO. 36

An Ordinance ordaining, laying out and opening a certain road in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to wit: Bailey Springs Road

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION I. That a certain road to be named Bailey Springs Road be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, extended and opened on a course, the centerline of which begins at a nail and washer marking the intersection of the centerline of Township Route 378, also known as Mentzer Gap Road, with the centerline of Bailey Springs Road, said nail and washer marking Station 0 + 00 of the centerline of Bailey Springs Road; thence with said centerline north 8 degrees 25 minutes east 309.69 feet to a point in the centerline of said road, said point marking the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 114.25 feet a distance of 72.48 feet to a point in the centerline of said road; thence in the same north 44 degrees 46 minutes east 125.0 feet to a point in the centerline of said road, said point marking the beginning of a curve to the left having a radius of 289.90 feet a distance of 126.16 feet to a point in the centerline of said road; thence in the same north 19 degrees 50 minutes east 127.46 feet to a point in the centerline of said road, said

point marking the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 2859.62 feet a distance of 213.78 feet to a point in the centerline of said road; thence in the same north 24 degrees 07 minutes east 124.35 feet to a spike marking Station 10 + 98.92, said spike marking the center of a cul-de-sac having a radius of 50 feet; said road having a total length of 1098.92 feet and being 33 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.


SECTION II. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a survey of the foregoing road showing the location thereof, as prepared by John H. McClellan, C. S., September 15, 1970.

SECTION III. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.


SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 2nd day of August, 1971.


