## ORDINANCE NO. 37

An Ordinance ordaining, laying out and opening a certain road in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to wit: Koons Road Extended.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION I. That a certain road to be named Koons Road Extended be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, extended and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at an iron pin marking the intersection of the center line of Pennsylvania Route 16 with the center line of Koons Road Extended, said iron pin marking Highway Station 1233+50 of the center line of Pennsylvania Route 16 and Station 0+00 of the center line of Koons Road Extended; thence with said center line North 21 degrees 00 minutes East to an iron pin on the center line of Township Route 400, said iron pin being South 79 degrees 51 minutes East 12.7 feet distant from an iron pin marking the intersection of the center lines of Township Routes 400 and 388, and marking Station 2+69.40 of Koons Road Extended, said road having a total length of 269.40 feet and being 33 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

SECTION II. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a survey of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, C. S., September 10, 1970.

SECTION III. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 4th day of October, 1971.
