ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, GRANTING TO WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY CERTAIN RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES IN, ALONG, OVER AND UNDER STREETS, ROADS, LANES, COURTS, CUL-DE-SACS, ALLEYS, PUBLIC WAYS, PUBLIC SQUARES AND OTHER PROPERTY OF THIS TOWNSHIP FOR USE IN CONNECTION WITH SAID AUTHORITY'S SANITARY SEWER AND WATER SYSTEMS AS THE SAME SHALL BE CONTEMPLATED OR SHALL EXIST FROM TIME TO TIME: AND PROVIDING FOR REGULATING THE MANNER IN WHICH SUCH RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES SHALL BE EXERCISED.

WHEREAS, Washington Township Municipal Authority (the "Authority"), pursuant to authority vested in it by law, plans to construct and to acquire certain sanitary sewerage collection, transmission, treatment and disposal system facilities required for rendering sewage services in and for parts of this Township, which facilities collectively are referred to herein as the "Sewer System".

WHEREAS, the Authority, pursuant to authority vested in it by resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, dated December 4, 1972, plans to construct and operate a water supply and distribution system in said Township and to acquire existing water facilities in said Township, which facilities collectively are referred to as the "Water System".

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:

Section 1: This Township does grant to the Authority, its successors and assigns, all easements, rights-of-way and other rights and privileges necessary and desirable in, along, over and under streets, roads, lanes, courts, cul-de-sacs, alley, public ways, public squares and other properties of this Township, together with free ingress, egress and regress therein and thereto, for use in connection with constructing, replacing, repairing, altering and maintaining the sewer system and the water system, as the same shall be contemplated or shall exist from time to time.

Section 2: The rights and privileges granted to the Authority under Section 1 shall be exercised by the Authority under and subject to such reasonable rules and regulations as shall be adopted and specified, from time to time, by resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.

Section 4: In the event any provision, section, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intention of this Board of Supervisors that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.
