ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 41, KNOWN AS THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance #41, setting speed limits on certain Township streets, on the 5th. day of September 1972; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors desire to supplement and amend said Ordinance to estavlish a speed limit on Township Route #378, known as the Mentzer Gap Road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, that Ordinance #41, adopted on September 5, 1972, is amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. The following speed limits are hereby established:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>	<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>
Mentzer Gap Road (TR378)	Traffic Route 16 and Glen Furney Road (LR 28024 and TR378)	40
Mentzer Gap Road (TR375)	Fish and Game Road (LR28024 and TR375) Country Club Road (LR28024 and TR356)	40

SECTION 2. All existing provisions of Ordinance No. 41 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.
