ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS  
TOWNSHIP, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE  
NO. 41, ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN  
STREETS AND ROADS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on September 5, 1972, enacted Ordinance No. 41, establishing speed limits on certain streets and roads within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors find that Jacob's Church Road T.R. 377, from Buchanan Trail East, Pa. Route 16, to the Adams County line is an "urban district" within the meaning of the Vehicle Code of 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, under the authority of Section 6109 of the Vehicle Code, desires to establish a maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour on said Jacob's Church Road, T.R. 377.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 41 is amended to provide a maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour on Jacob's Church Road, T.R. 377, from Buchana Trail East, Pa. Route 16, to the Adams County lien.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforce-able in accordance with the provisions of said Ordinance No. 41.

SECTION 3. All other provisions of said Ordinance No. 41 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from the enactment hereof.
