ORDINANCE NO. 75

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE
NO. 21, LIMITING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
ON SUMMIT PLAZA TO ONE-WAY TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of this Township, by Ordinance No. 21, enacted May 4, 1964, designated the Township Road known as Summit Plaza in Blue Ridge Summit as a one-way thoroughfare for west-bound traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desire to repeal said Ordinance No. 21, as one-way traffic on Summit Plaza is no longer in the best interests of the general public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, as follows:

- 1. Ordinance No. 21, enacted May 4, 1964, designating Summit Plaza as a one-way thoroughfare, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- 2. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from enactment hereof.
