

ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING AN AGRICULTURAL AREA WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE AGRICULTURAL AREA SECURITY LAW, ACT NO. 1981-43, 3 P.S. §901 et. seq.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of this Township has received a proposal for the creation of an agricultural area within the Township, and has received proposed modifications to said proposal; and

WHEREAS, said proposal and modifications thereto have been reviewed by the Township Planning Commission and the Township Agricultural Area Advisory Committee, and the Board of Supervisors has received the recommendations of the Planning Commission and the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has conducted a public hearing relative to said proposal and modifications; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes it is in the best interests and general welfare of the residents of the Township to create an agricultural area within the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, in accordance with the provisions of the Agricultural Area Security Law, Act No. 1981-43, 3 P.S. §901, et. seq., as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, an agricultural area comprising those lands shown on the map attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance, which shall hereafter be referred to as the Washington Township Agricultural Area Map.

SECTION 2. From the effective date of this Ordinance, those lands comprising said agricultural area shall be subject to the provisions of the Agricultural Area Security Law, Act No. 1981-43, 3 P.S. §901 et. seq.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.
