

TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 93

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY AUTHORITY OF AND PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE V OF ACT NO. 247 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVED JULY 31, 1968, KNOWN AND CITED AS THE "PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPALITIES PLANNING CODE", AND ANY AMENDMENTS AND SUPPLEMENTS THERETO AMENDING SECTION 602 AND SECTION 603 OF ORDINANCE NO. 57, ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP ON DECEMBER 20, 1976, AND KNOWN AS THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, Section 602 (2)(b) of Washington Township Ordinance No. 57, known as the Washington Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, provides for the use of either CP-2 or ID-2A as the paved surface of streets; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desire to require all new streets opened and improved in accordance with the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance to have ID-2A surfaces; and

WHEREAS, Section 603 (2)(a) requires developers to provide subdivisions and land developments which are within 1,000 feet of a public water supply system with a complete water main supply system to be connected to the existing water main supply system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desire to require developers to provide fire hydrants under such circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, that Ordinance No. 57, known as the Washington Township Subdivision and Land development Ordinance, be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 602 (2)(b) of Ordinance No. 57 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 602. STREETS

2. The following standards shall apply to road base and paved surfaces:

- b. ~~Paved surface~~, according to PennDOT specifications:
ID-2A.

SECTION 2. Section 603 (2)(a) of Ordinance No. 57 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 603. SEWER AND WATER SYSTEMS

1. Water

a. Where a public water main supply system is within one thousand (1,000') feet of, or where plans approved by the Board of Supervisors provide for the installation of such public water facilities to within one thousand (1,000') feet of a proposed subdivision of land development, the developer shall provide the subdivision or land development with a complete water main supply system, together with fire hydrants to serve the subdivision or land development in accordance with specifications provided by the provider of water to the subdivision or land development, to be connected to the existing or proposed water main supply system.

SECTION 3. In all other respects the provisions of Ordinance No. 57 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
