Certified Copy of Resolution

I, Melvin T. Sease, Secretary of the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, do hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the Resolution adopted by the Supervisors of Washington Township at their regular meeting held March 7, 1966:


"WHEREAS, the Act of the Pennsylvania Legislature approved August 19, 1965, and known as Act No. 192, authorizes Townships of the Second Class to direct the assessor in the Township to inspect and reassess all taxable property in the Township to which major improvements have been made after original tax duplicates for any calendar year have been prepared so that such property may then be added to the duplicate and be taxable for Township purposes at the reassessed valuation for that proportionate part of the fiscal year of the Township remaining after the property was improved, and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, desire to avail themselves of the provisions of said Act,

RESOLVED, that the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, do hereby request and direct the Chief Real Estate Assessor of the County of Franklin to make interim assessments in the Township of Washington of any construction of a building, or building, after the

Township Supervisors have prepared a duplicate of assessment of Township taxes in any calendar year, and such building is not included in the tax duplicate of the Township for said year, and to certify said assessments to the Secretary of Washington Township Supervisors forthwith upon the making of the same."

Upon motion made by Merle C. Eigenbrode and seconded by Melvin T. Sease, the foregoing preamble and resolution was unanimously adopted.
