

RESOLUTION NO. 180

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF ANTRIM TOWNSHIP, BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE, BOROUGH OF MONT ALTO, QUINCY TOWNSHIP, AND WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP ALL OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A JOINT RECYCLING COALITION CALLED THE SOUTHERN FRANKLIN COUNTY RECYCLING COALITION.

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of Antrim Township, Borough of Greencastle, Borough of Mont Alto, Quincy Township, and Washington Township of Franklin County, Pennsylvania are desirous of forming a coalition of governments in order to facilitate a cooperative recycling program in Southern Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, this coalition of governments shall be called the Southern Franklin County Recycling Coalition and consist of the above listed municipalities; and

WHEREAS, said Coalition plans to apply for joint funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources for its initial recycling program; and

WHEREAS, said municipalities, by executing this resolution obligate their municipalities to their share of the initial program costs; and

WHEREAS, said Coalition further agrees to support and sustain the recycling program in the future in their communities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Coalition that the following is hereby adopted:

SECTION 1. NAME.

The name of this Coalition shall be Southern Franklin County Recycling Coalition.

SECTION 2. MUNICIPALITIES.

The Municipalities of Antrim Township, Borough of Greencastle, Borough of Mont Alto, Quincy Township, and Washington Township by executing this resolution agree to become part of this coalition.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE OF COALITION.

The purpose of this Coalition is to provide the following

1. A joint and similar recycling program to serve the residents of Southern Franklin County.
2. An education program for all residents to avoid confusion and to provide awareness to the values of recycling.
3. To apply for grant funding from Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources for the coalition joint recycling program.
4. To coordinate and generally oversee the recycling program in each of the municipalities.

SECTION 4. MUNICIPAL OBLIGATION.

The member municipalities, by executing this resolution, agree to obligate their municipality for their pro-rated portion of all agreed upon costs of the recycling program initiated by this coalition, as set forth below.

SECTION 5. INITIAL GRANT

The coalition will apply for a Section 902 grant for recycling containers and education programs for the coalition members. Each municipality agrees to provide local funding for their containers based on the following:

In addition, each municipality agrees to provide a pro-rated share of the education material costs based on the population of each municipality divided into the cost of the education program.

SECTION 6. GRANT REIMBURSEMENT.

Upon receiving grant funding from DER each member of the Coalition shall be reimbursed on a pro-rated basis, in

accordance with the total dollars spent by each member in comparison to the total dollars spent by the Coalition.

SECTION 7. MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION

The Coalition shall have the right to modify this resolution and their joint understanding regarding recycling upon the agreement of all member municipalities. In addition thereto, any member municipality shall have the right to withdraw from the Coalition upon resolution adopted by the governing body of said municipality as long as no outstanding debts to the Coalition remain payable, by said withdrawing municipality.
