

## HOME INVENTORY INFORMATION

It is important to mark your property with a special number that is unique to you and/or your family. The number is commonly referred to as an Owner Applied Number (OAN). Additionally, take photographs of your valuables.

The number can be marked on your property with a permanent marker or an engraver.

1. Mark valuables with your driver's license number or tax I.D. Number.
2. To ensure no one alters your number, put the two letters of your state at the start and end of your number.
3. NEVER use your social security number.

## WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

Should you be the victim of a crime, you can use your OAN to assist police in the identification of stolen/recovered items. Often criminals avoid stealing items that are marked because they are hard to re-sell.

You should not mark paintings, antiques or other items that you may want to sell. Keep your list in a safe place. Do not store your list/photos on a computer.
